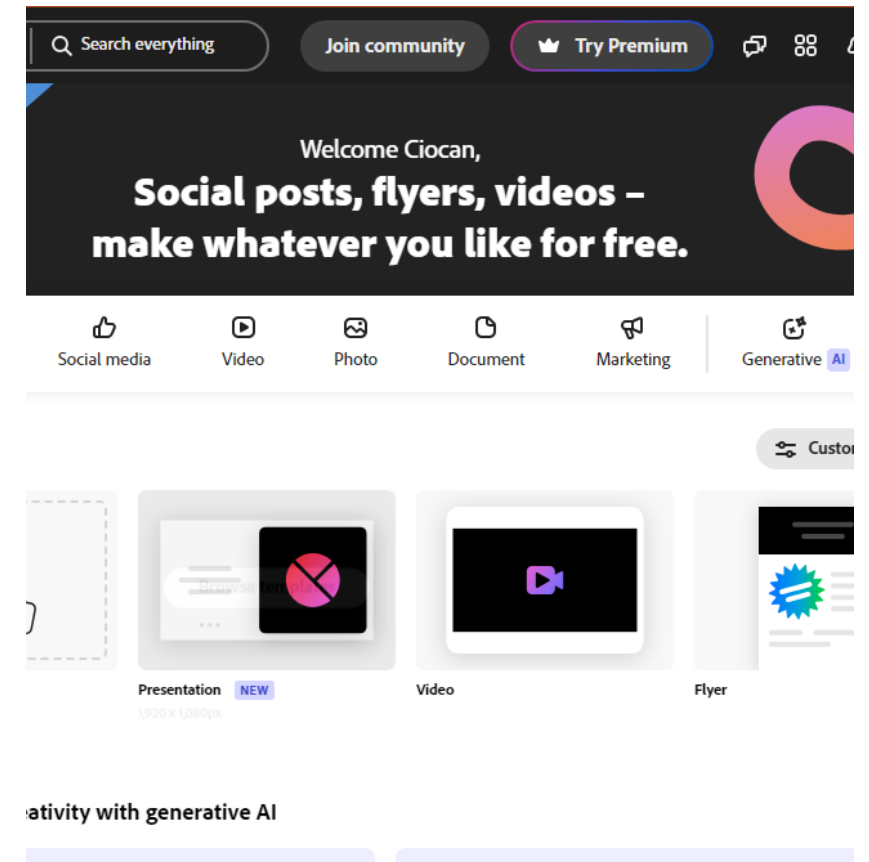

- Access options to start new projects, view existing designs, and explore templates.



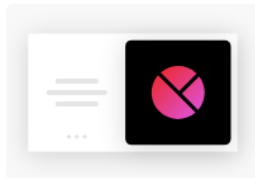
Creating a New Project

- Alternatively, select from popular templates for quick starts.

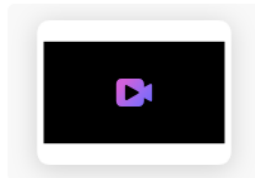

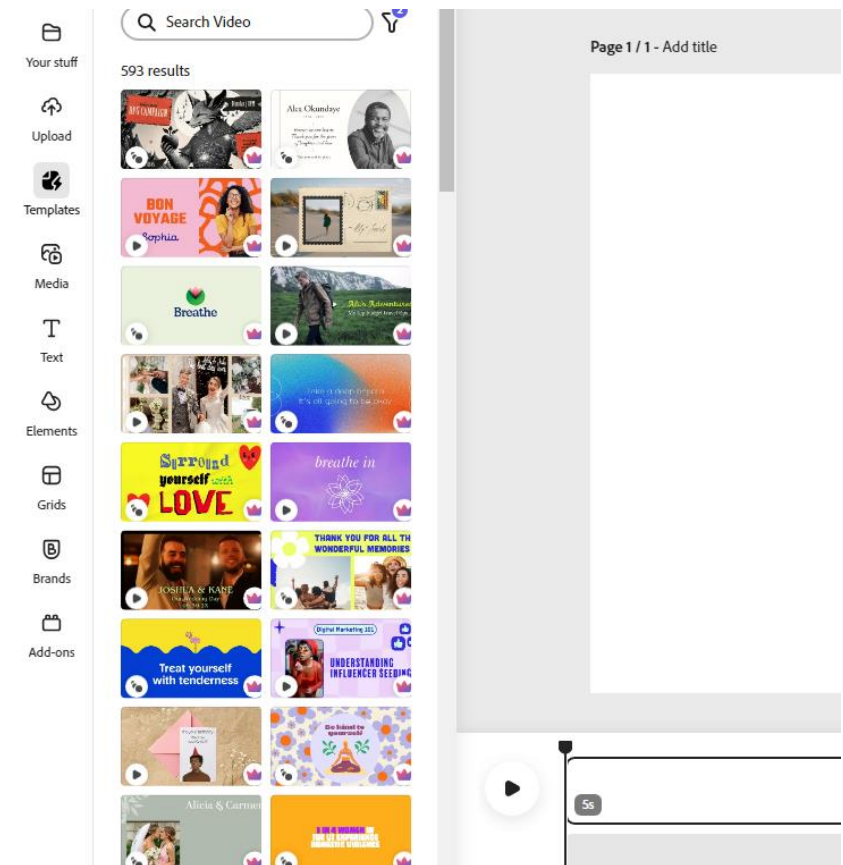
Exploring Templates

- Browse through Adobe Spark's library of templates.
- Use the search bar to find templates relevant to your project.
- Click on a template to open it in the editor.



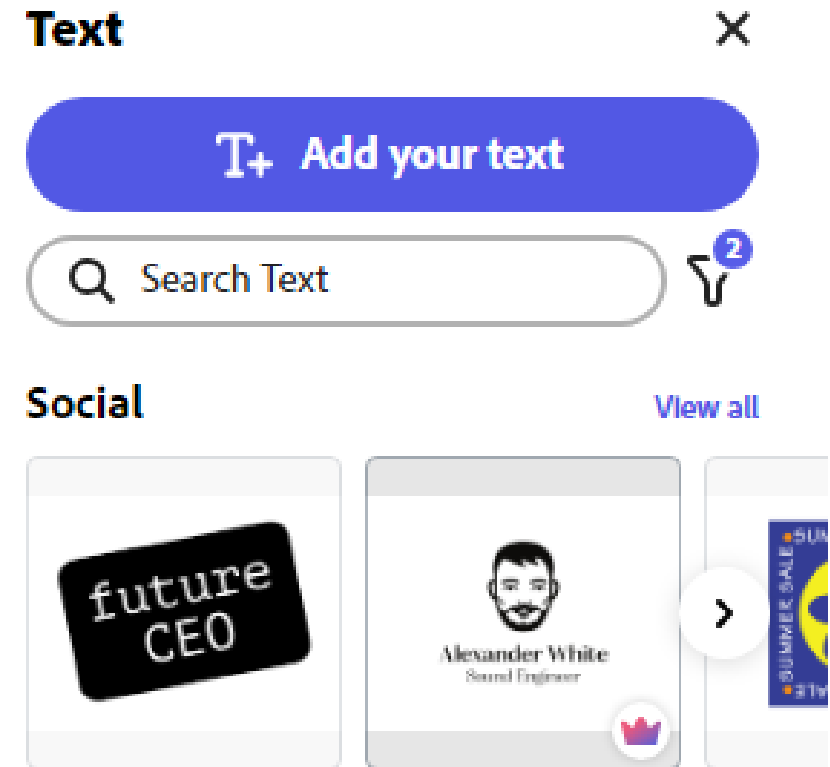
Customizing Your Design

- Use the toolbar on the left to add elements: Text, Photos, Icons, Design Assets, Backgrounds.
- Click on any element to edit it.
- Customize text by changing the font, size, color, and alignment.
- Drag and drop elements to arrange them on your canvas.



Adding Text and Elements

- Click on the “Text” tab to add headings, subheadings, or body text.
- Use the “Photos” tab to add images from Adobe Spark’s library or upload your own.
- Explore the “Icons” tab for various icons and illustrations.
- Customize elements to suit your design.





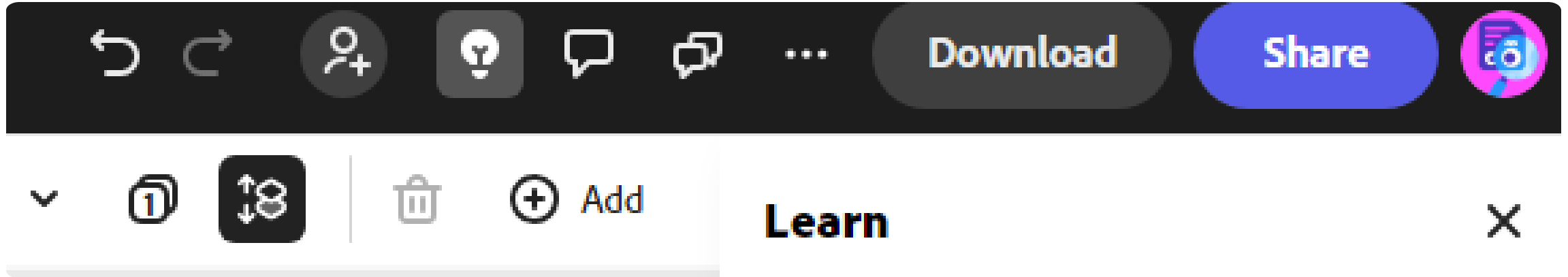

Uploading Your Own Media

- Click on the “Upload” to add images from your computer.

- Click on the “Share” button in the top right corner to share your project.
- Choose to share directly to social media, get a shareable link, or invite others via email.
- Download your project by clicking the “Download” button.
